INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT

To the shareholders Southern Province Cement Company (A Saudi Joint Stock Company) Abha, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed statement of financial position of **Southern Province Cement Company** - a Saudi Joint Stock Company (the "Company") as of 30 September 2025, and the related interim condensed statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income for the three-month and nine-month periods then ended and the interim condensed statement of changes in shareholders equity and cash flows for the nine-month period then ended and other explanatory notes.

Management is responsible for the preparation and presentation of these interim condensed financial statements in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34 - "Interim Financial Reporting" (IAS 34) that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on this interim condensed financial statements based on our review.

1. GENERAL

Southern Province Cement Company was established as a Saudi Joint Stock Company ("the Company") under the Royal Decree No. M/3 on 12/2/1398H based on the companies' law and executive regulations from the Ministry of Commerce.

The Company's main activity is to manufacture and produce cement, its derivatives and accessories, and to trade in those products and to carry out all works related directly or indirectly to the realization of these purposes.

As at 30 September 2025, the Company authorized, subscribed and fully paid-up capital amounted to \pm 1.4 billion (2024: \pm 1.4 billion) divided into 140 million ordinary shares (2024: 140 million ordinary shares) of \pm 10 each (2024: \pm 10).

In accordance with the company's by-laws, the ordinary general assembly, based on the proposal of the Board of Directors, may decide to form reserves, to the extent that achieves the interest of the company or ensures the distribution of fixed dividend as much as possible to shareholders.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION

a) Statement of compliance

These interim condensed financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the International Accounting Standard 34, "Interim Financial Reporting" ("IAS 34") that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia ("KSA") and other standards and pronouncements that are issued by the Saudi Organization for Chartered and Professional Accountants ("SOCPA").

These interim condensed financial statements do not include all the information and disclosures required in the full set of annual financial statements and should be read in conjunction with the Company's annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024. However, selected explanatory notes are included to explain events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the Company's financial position and performance since the last annual financial statements. In addition, results for the interim period ended 30 September 2025 are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the financial year ending 31 December 2025.

b) Basis of measurement

The interim condensed financial statements have been prepared on historical cost convention using the accruals basis of accounting and going concern concept except for employee defined benefits obligations which are measured at present value for the future obligations and provision for quarry rehabilitation is measured at the present value of the expected cost of resurfacing the site using the discount rate as at the contract inception date.

c) Functional and presentation currency

These interim condensed financial statements have been presented in Saudi Arabian Riyals (4) which is the Company's functional and presentation currency.

3. USE OF JUDGEMENTS AND ESTIMATES

The preparation of the interim condensed financial statements requires management to make judgments and estimates that affect the application of accounting policies and reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenses and actual results may differ from these estimates.

Estimates and assumptions are based on previous experience and factors that may include expecting suitable future events which are used estimate book value of assets and liabilities from other resources and estimates and assumptions are continuously being evaluated. Revised accounting estimates are also reviewed in the period in which the estimates are revised in the audit period and future periods, if the changed estimates affect current and future periods.

The significant judgments and estimates made by management in applying the Company's accounting policies are consistent with those disclosed in the annual financial statements.

4. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies adopted by the Company in preparing the interim condensed financial statements are consistent with those followed in preparing the annual financial statements of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2024.

- 11.1 On 8 June 2023, the Company renewed the facilities agreement and rescheduled the bank facilities with a local bank, so that the total amount of the facilities amounted to £ 1.68 billion as at 30 September 2025 (31 December 2024: £ 1.63 billion), and the utilized balance of facilities at 30 September 2025 amounted to £ 1,238 million (31 December 2024: £ 649 million) to be paid in variable quarterly installments starting on 6 October 2025 until the end of the year 2033. These facilities are secured by a promissory note.
- 11.2 The loan agreements include covenants which, among other things, require certain financial ratios to be maintained. All banking facilities carry agreed upon commissions according to the commercial rates prevailing in the market

16. CONTINGENCIES AND CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

- a) As at 30 September 2025, the contingent liabilities against issued banking letters of guarantee amounted to # 65,7 million (30 September 2024: # 45.8 million).
- b) As at 30 September 2025, the capital commitments related to projects in progress amounted to #184 million (30 September 2024: #1.29 billion).
- c) There are legal cases filed against the Company which are still under litigation. Based on the assessment of the Company's management and its legal advisor, there is no expectation of any financial obligation arising from these cases. Accordingly, no provision has been recognized in respect of these matters.

17. PRIOR YEARS ADJUSTMENTS

The financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024 and the opening balances as at 1 January 2024 have been restated and reclassified due to the following reasons:

a. Borrowing Costs

The Company did not recognize interest expenses in accordance with the requirements of the International Financial Reporting Standards, as it capitalized interest costs that were not eligible for capitalization within property and equipment. Accordingly, it was determined that an amount of \pm 12 million in 2023 and \pm 16.4 million in 2024 had been capitalized to the construction-in-progress related to the Jazan Plant, whereas these amounts should have been recognized as finance costs in the statements of profit or loss for the years 2023 and 2024, respectively.

The Company has appropriately reversed the accounting impact, and the opening retained earnings as at 1 January 2024 have been adjusted to reflect this correction.

b. Loan Arrangement Fees

The Company did not recognize the loan arrangement fees amounting to \pm 2.8 million in accordance with the requirements of the International Financial Reporting Standards, as the full amount was expensed in the 2024 statement of profit or loss instead of being accounted for using the effective interest rate method.

The Company has appropriately reversed the accounting impact, and the opening retained earnings as at 1 January 2024 have been adjusted to reflect this correction.

c. Other Debit Balances

The Company did not capitalize an amount of # 7 million within property, plant and equipment, representing a payment made pursuant to a court judgment related to the Company's acquisition of a portion of the Jazan Plant land, which was previously owned by another party. The Company obtained a final judgment transferring the legal title of the land to the Company on 1 July 2005, and the Company has exercised effective control over the land, thereby meeting the recognition requirements of IAS 16 "Property, Plant and Equipment". Accordingly, the Company has appropriately reversed the accounting impact to reflect this correction

d. Accrual of 2023 Production Bonus

During 2024, the Company identified that it had not recognized the bonus expense on an accrual basis in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards. Accordingly, the bonus amounting to # 9.75 million was recognized in the statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income for the period ended 30 June 2024, whereas it should have been recognized in the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2023.

The Company has appropriately reversed the accounting impact by reducing cost of revenue, selling and distribution expenses, and general and administrative expenses by the respective amounts in the statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income for the period ended 30 June 2024, and by adjusting the opening retained earnings as at 1 January 2024.
