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Saudi Cement Sector | Monthly Report | October 2017

Cement dispatches: Cement dispatches for the month of October-2017 stood at 4.10mn tons, compared to 4.39mn tons in October-2016, depicting a decline of 6.58%YoY, and an increase of 30.37%MoM. We believe that the YoY decline is ascribed to the continued pressure on the sectors fundamentals, and the MoM increase is attributed to Hajj season in September. Clinker inventory continued to increase and stood at 35.12mn ton, depicting an increase of 29.7%YoY and 1.1%QoQ. For 10M-2017, cement dispatches stood at 39.35mn ton compared to 47.07mn ton in 10M-2016, depicting a decline of 16.4%YoY.






Clinker Inventories showed an increase of 1.1%MoM and stood at 35.12MT compared to 34.74MT in September 2017.


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City cement showed the highest increase by 24.7% YoY, followed by Hail cement and Arabian cement by 12.7% YoY and 12.4% YoY. While Najran cement declined the most by 37.1% YoY, followed by Yamama cement and Riyadh cement with decline of 32.4% YoY and 31.9% YoY, respectively.

Cement Dispatches for 10M-2017






For 10M-2017, city cement was the only company to show growth (9.5%YoY). While Najran cement and Northern cement showed a decline of 44.7%YoY and 42.9%YoY respectively.

Sales / Production for 10M-2017



Riyadh cement and United cement showed the highest cement sales / clinker production ratio of 131.4% and 117.6% respectively. On the other hand, Hail cement and Umm AlQura cement showed a cement sales/ clinker production ratio of 53.6% and 66.9% respectively.

AlSafwa cement showed the highest increase of 155.6%YoY in its inventory level, followed by Southern cement which showed an increase of 110.6%YoY. On the other hand, Riyadh cement was the only company to show a decline in its inventories by 21.7%YoY.



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
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
Market Share - October 2017



Southern and Yanbu cement recorded the highest market share, in October 2017, of 12.7% and 11.8%, respectively. While Tabuk cement, recorded the lowest market share of 2.4%. City cement showed the highest increase in its market share from 5.3% to 7.1%, while Najran cement showed a decline in its market share standing at 3.0% from 4.5% in October 2017.

Market Share TTM






On TTM basis, Yanbu and Southern cement recorded the highest market share of 12.5% and 11.6% followed by Saudi cement with market share of 11.0%

EV / Ton (in '000 SAR)


